2009 -2010 SCHOOL IMPACT GRANT**

The Iberville Foundation presents the 2009 - 2010 School Impact Program! School Impact Grants provide funding for innovative and creative projects, which promote academic excellence for a school, a grade level, or a subject area within that school. The audience is larger, the objectives more ambitious and the planning and challenges operate on a broader scale than Grants for Teachers. The Iberville Foundation plans to award School Impact Grants in amounts up to \$2,000.00.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

School Impact Grants must be tied into the school improvement plan.

All school impact grants must have an academic focus.

Only ONE application per school may be submitted, therefore School Impact Grant projects should address a school's top academic priority. A Project Team of 4 or more members drawn from the school's faculty, administration and/or community members should be assembled by the Principal and Grant Project Manager in order to coordinate project planning and implementation.

Applications are anonymous. Applications will be DISQUALIFIED if they include name, school or principal references in any section other than the Cover Sheet.

Who is eligible? Iberville Parish Schools, Pre-K -12. Teachers who apply as part of a group for a School Impact Grant may apply for Iberville Foundation Grants For Teachers. However, the grant Project Manager (the author of the grant and main coordinator) cannot apply for a separate teacher grant with the Iberville Foundation.

How do schools apply? Fill out the Iberville Foundation Grant Application and return the correct number of copies of each section to the Foundation office by **4:00 pm on Tuesday, April 21, 2009**. **Submit: Cover Sheet -1 copy (Original signed by Project Manager and Principal) and 3 copies of Application (pages 1-4).** Each project selected will be for implementation and completion during the 2009 - 2010 school year. A Project Evaluation will be due in May 2010.

How will applications be evaluated? Applications will be evaluated on a competitive basis by a Grant Reader Team, comprised of community, education and business volunteers.

What are the expenditure guidelines? Budget requests may include materials needed to accomplish the project, consultants who are necessary for the successful implementation of the project, equipment, and/or field trips ONLY if an integral component of the project. Substitute pay, requests for travel, out of state conference fees, and/or teachers' salaries or stipend pay will **NOT** be funded. Student hands-on projects are preferred. Projects cannot displace or replace programs funded through the Iberville Parish General Fund, the Minimum Foundation Program (MFP) or the State General Fund.
