

Scores Soar in Iberville Parish!

Congratulations to our students and teachers. Your hard work, dedication and persistence have paid off. Principals, content coaches, administrators, paraprofessionals, support personnel, families and community are also recognized for their contributions to our students' successes!

Scores show that Iberville 4th graders had a passing rate of 83%, while the state's average passing rate was 77%. The 8th grade passing rate for Iberville was 67% vs. the state's 74%. However, Iberville 8th graders improved by 5%, while the state's average improved by only 3%, demonstrating the district's continuing progress to close the gap in scores.

iLEAP scores also showed significant growth across all grade levels in both ELA and Math, with one exception. This is a first!

Our focus on a system of 'one', the curriculum, and high expectations, working with teachers, administrators, students, parents and the board on academic success has led to this improvement.

Iberville Parish School District has repeatedly renewed its commitment to achieving a successful educational system for the children of Iberville.
