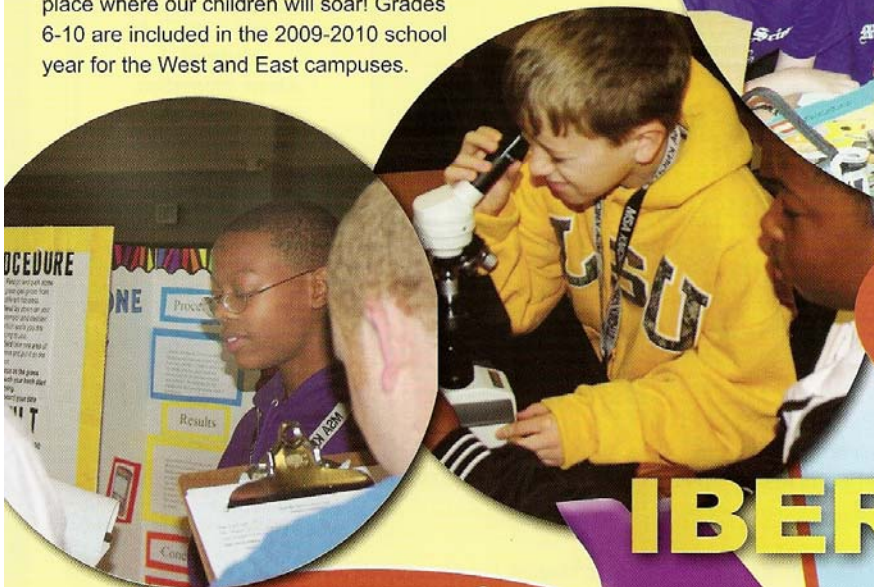

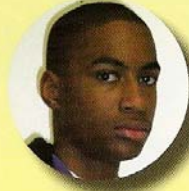
## Why go to Iberville MSA Academy?
